

TSCA-Statement – EPA January 2021 rev 1.2

The following statement applies to all unassembled printed circuit boards that we **AQC BV** delivers.

The US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published the final rules¹ under Section 6(h) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) for five Persistent, Bio-accumulative and Toxic (PBT) chemicals. It is to reduce the risk of exposure to humans and the environment. This rule will be effective from 5 February 2021.

Based on the information currently available, we can assure that none of the below listed substances are contained in the Printed Circuit Boards AQC delivered.

- decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE) (CAS No. 1163-19-5)
- phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1)) (CAS No. 68937-41-7)
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP) (CAS No. 732-26-3)
- hexachlorobutadiene (HCBd) (CAS No.87-68-3)
- pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP) (CAS No.133-49-3)


