

TSCA-Statement - EPA January 2021 rev 1.2

The following statement applies to all unassembled printed circuit boards that we AQC BV delivers.

The US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published the final rules under Section 6(h) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) for five Persistent, Bioaccumulative and Toxic (PBT) chemicals. It is to reduce the risk of exposure to humans and the environment. This rule will be effective from 5 February 2021.

Based on the information currently available, we can assure that none of the below listed substances are contained in the Printed Circuit Boards AQC delivered.

- decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE) (CAS No. 1163–19–5)
- phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1)) (CAS No. 68937-41-7)
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP) (CAS No. 732-26-3)
- hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD) (CAS No.87-68-3)
- pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP) (CAS No.133-49-3)
